Conditions of Entry

The application included on the reverse side hereof is subject to acceptance by the PNW Section, PGA of America, and applicant agrees that in the event of its acceptance, it may be rejected or revoked at any time thereafter. To be accepted, entries must be signed, paid, and received at Tournament Headquarters. Therefore, players submitting entries are encouraged to allow ample time for delay or error in transmission of their entries.

Both the said Application and Applicant's participation in the aforesaid Invitational Championship (hereafter referred to as the "Championship") are subject to all Rules, Regulations, provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America and other conditions applicable to the Championship, as well as to the terms and conditions of the agreement between the PNW Section, PGA of America and the Championship sponsor(s) with respect to same.

NON-METAL SPIKE RELEASE: If it is the requirement of the Host Club that all individuals using the Host Club golf course wear spikeless/non-metal golf shoes. This requirement is a policy of the Host Club and is not a policy of the Pacific Northwest Section of the PGA of America ("Section"). The use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes may result in the participant slipping on wet or damp surfaces (inclusive of but not necessarily limited to turf area, wooden areas such as bridges and pathways, etc.) and reduced traction on non-level areas of the golf course. As evidenced by the participant's signature on the front of this entry, the participant acknowledges that potential dangers relative to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes have been disclosed to participant and participant agrees to assume the risk of sustaining injury arising from or attributable to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises. The participant here releases the Section and Section's officers, directors, members, employees, successors and assigns (the "Indemnified Parties") from any and all claims for loss damage, inclusive of but not limited to personal injury, whether or not caused by participant's use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises in connection with the tournament. The consideration for this release is the permission granted by Section to the participant to participate in the golf tournament. This release binds not only the participant, but also the participant's spouse, heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

By this application, an applicant consents to references to him and pictures of him and his play in any publicity, radio and television broadcasting and other exhibition or publication, including their use in any commercial manner.

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS: The term "eligible player" is defined, for this Championship, as: (1) all Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America members (except those classified as "F" or "Reserve"); (2) all PNW Section, PGA of America associates with full Section Playing Privileges; (3) all Amateurs (as defined by the USGA) with current USGA handicap indexes. Contestants entering as amateurs may not accept professional prize money.

Entry priority will be as outlined in Section 8 of the PNW PGA Tournament Regulations.

FIELD: 48 teams of two professionals and two amateurs.

STARTING TIMES: Groupings will be available at the Section office by July 3 or at www.pnwpga.com. Competitors are responsible for knowing their starting time and tee. Players will not be called to their starting tee.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Monday, July 13 is available for practice rounds. Paid teams may schedule a time by emailing Robin Lindsey at rlindsey@pgahq.com. Times are available between 8am-4pm for your team. You have one comp'd team practice round included in your team entry fee.

CART RESERVATIONS: Cart reservations must be made **NO LATER than July 1**. Contact Arrowhead at (503) 829-8080

TOURNAMENT FORMAT: Entry into the championship is by four-man team – two professionals and two amateurs. Make your own team. Only entries with complete payment will be accepted.

Teams will play together.

There are two team competitions over the 36 holes – best 2 net of the 4 and each professional will play a net four-ball with one amateur.

Handicaps at 80% will be used in the team games.

The championship is a 36-hole stroke play with professional and amateur purses.

There is no maximum handicap for entry (18 max. in the competition), however, all players will play from the championship tees and there will be no individual net amateur. All players will be governed by the Rules of Golf, Pace of Play, the Section Hard Card, the Section Dress Code and the Section Cell phone regulations.

Professional and amateur entry includes tee gifts, range balls and a practice round on Monday, July 13.

SEPARATE TEE POLICY: Although competing from separate tees, men and women shall compete for the same purse.
