TEAM ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility has been expanded to include teams having a relationship of head professional and THEIR assistant. Directors of Golf and General Managers may play with their assistant professionals. Directors of Instruction may play with their assistants. Professionals with an independent position (many A-6's) at the facility are not eligible. Multiple teams from one facility and head professionals entering with up to 3 of their assistants are eligible on a space available basis. Assistants employed in a seasonal capacity may play if they are returning to the same employment as last season. *Non-traditional teams are encouraged to consult with Molly Cooper prior to entry to ensure eligibility.*

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The application included on the reverse side hereof is subject to acceptance by the PNW Section, PGA of America, and applicant agrees that in the event of its acceptance, it may be rejected or revoked at any time thereafter. To be accepted, entries must be signed, paid, and received at Tournament Headquarters. Therefore, players submitting entries are encouraged to allow ample time for delay or error in transmission of their entries. Acceptance of professional entry is subject to professional agreeing to play in one day of the Sponsor Pro-Am event if asked to do so by the Executive Director or his representative.

Both the said Application and Applicant's participation in the aforesaid Invitational Championship (hereafter referred to as the "Championship") are subject to all Rules, Regulations, provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America and other conditions applicable to the Championship, as well as to the terms and conditions of the agreement between the PNW Section, PGA of America and the Championship sponsor(s) with respect to same.

NON-METAL SPIKE RELEASE: If it is the requirement of the Host Club that all individuals using the Host Club golf course wear spikeless/non-metal golf shoes. This requirement is a policy of the Host Club and is not a policy of the Pacific Northwest Section of the PGA of America ("Section"). The use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes may result in the participant slipping on wet or damp surfaces (inclusive of but not necessarily limited to turf area, wooden areas such as bridges and pathways, etc.) and reduced traction on non-level areas of the golf course. As evidenced by the participant's signature on the front of this entry, the participant acknowledges that potential dangers relative to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes have been disclosed to participant and participant agrees to assume the risk of sustaining injury arising from or attributable to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises. The participant here releases the Section and Section's officers, directors, members, employees, successors and assigns (the "Indemnified Parties") from any and all claims for loss damage, inclusive of but not limited to personal injury, whether or not caused by participant's use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises in connection with the tournament. The consideration for this release is the permission granted by Section to the participant to participate in the golf tournament. This release binds not only the participant, but also the participant's spouse, heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

By this application, an applicant consents to references to him and pictures of him and his play in any publicity, radio and television broadcasting and other exhibition or publication, including their use in any commercial manner.

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS: The term "eligible player" is defined, for this Championship, as: (1) all Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America members (except those classified as "F" or "Inactive"); (2) all PNW Section, PGA of America apprentices with full Section Playing Privileges.

Entry priority will be as outlined in Section 8 of the PNW PGA Tournament Regulations.

FIELD: 60 teams

SKINS: At 85% participation - \$2,000 additional in skins.

STARTING TIMES: Groupings available at the Section office on Friday, March 19 or on the the website at www.pnwpga.com. Competitors are responsible for knowing their starting time and tee. Players will not be called to their starting tee.

DRESS CODE: Contestants may not wear jeans, shorts, or skirts in the championship or any qualifying tournament.

NON-METAL SPIKES: When it is a condition of the competition that metal spikes are prohibited, traction systems using any form of metal spike will be prohibited. Penalty for Breach - *Disqualification.*
