Washington PGA Championship

Competition will be gross match play. Competitors are to arrange their own site and date to play their matches, but matches must be played within the time frame established by the Tournament Committee (usually 3-4 weeks). Default sites and dates will **not** be established by the Committee. A competitor not present for an agreed upon match shall be deemed to have conceded the match. If neither player is present for a designated match, the match may be rescheduled as long as it is before the deadline. If not prior to the deadline, both are deemed to have forfeited and the next opponent will receive a bye. All disputes shall be resolved by the Tournament Committee and its decision shall be final. Match deadlines will be forwarded to the competitors in a timely manner after the seeding event. **The tournament finals will be played on a designated date and at a designated location.**

TOURNAMENT BRACKET

The field will consist of a normal 64 player bracket. Three quarters of the bracket will be filled by Western Washington Chapter professionals seeded by their play in the "Champions Pro-Am". The fourth quarter bracket will be seeded using 8 professionals in a Central Washington Chapter bracket and 8 professionals in an Inland Empire Chapter bracket. If either of these two Chapters is short of players, the other Chapter may supplement that bracket with its players. Thus, the winner of the Central Washington "mini-bracket" will face the winner of the Inland Empire "mini-bracket" to determine who will play against a Western Washington professional in the semi-finals of the tournament. New in 2010, we will have a drop down bracket for those who lose their first round match. There will be a small purse attached to the bracket. Thus all pros will play at least two matches.

The Chapters may select any method they deem fair for selecting the players to participate, including a qualifying event. The Chapters may also add an additional entry fee to that qualifier or selection process to benefit the winners or otherwise. Such additional fee will remain in the Chapters and be paid separately from the main tournament entry.

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS

Entrants must be active members or apprentices with full Section playing privileges. Suspended, Class F, or Inactive members are not eligible.
