ELIGIBILITY

Open to any PNW Section PGA Members (except those classified as "F" or "Inactive") and eligible Apprentices with full Section playing privileges that are in the Western Washington, Central Washington, Inland Empire and Western Montana Chapters who will reach their 50th birthday on or before April 28, 2010. Amateurs (Pro-Am only) must have a current, valid USGA handicap. *There is no handicap limit for amateurs, but a maximum index of 25.0 will be allowed for the competition for those players exceeding this index. See reverse side for complete eligibility details. The revision in effect on April 23, 2010 will be used for this event.

TOURNAMENT DETAILS ON REVERSE SIDE

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The application included on the reverse side hereof is subject to acceptance by the PNW Section, PGA of America, and applicant agrees that in the event of its acceptance, it may be rejected or revoked at any time thereafter. To be accepted, entries must be signed, paid, and received at Tournament Headquarters. Therefore, players submitting entries are encouraged to allow ample time for delay or error in transmission of their entries.

Both the said Application and Applicant's participation in the aforesaid Invitational Championship (hereafter referred to as the "Championship") are subject to all Rules, Regulations, provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America and other conditions applicable to the Championship, as well as to the terms and conditions of the agreement between the PNW Section, PGA of America and the Championship sponsor(s) with respect to same.

NON-METAL SPIKE RELEASE (if facility is spikeless): It is the requirement of the Host Club that all individuals using the Host Club golf course wear spikeless/non-metal golf shoes. This requirement is a policy of the Host Club and is not a policy of the Pacific Northwest Section of the PGA of America ("Section"). The use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes may result in the participant slipping on wet or damp surfaces (inclusive of but not necessarily limited to turf area, wooden areas such as bridges and pathways, etc.) and reduced traction on non-level areas of the golf course. As evidenced by the participant's signature on the front of this entry, the participant acknowledges that potential dangers relative to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes have been disclosed to participant and participant agrees to assume the risk of sustaining injury arising from or attributable to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises. The participant here releases the Section and Section's officers, directors, members, employees, successors and assigns (the "Indemnified Parties") from any and all claims for loss damage, inclusive of but not limited to personal injury, whether or not caused by participant's use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises in connection with the tournament. The consideration for this release is the permission granted by Section to the participant to participate in the golf tournament. This release binds not only the participant, but also the participant's spouse, heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

By this application, an applicant consents to references to him and pictures of him and his play in any publicity, radio and television broadcasting and other exhibition or publication, including their use in any commercial manner.

ELIGIBLE PLAYERS: Open to all PNW Section PGA Members (except those classified as "F" or "Inactive", and eligible Apprentices with full Section playing privileges that are in the Western Washington, Central Washington, Inland Empire and Western Montana Chapters who will reach their 50th birthday on or before April 29, 2009.

Amateurs must have a current, valid USGA handicap. There is no handicap limit for amateurs, but a maximum index of 25.0 will be allowed for the competition for those players exceeding this index. The revision in effect on April 23, 2010 will be used for this event.

Professionals may not enter the Washington PGA Match Play Championship without entering the Pro-Am.

Entry priority will be as follows: Eligible host professionals have reserved spots but must submit applications by the Close of Entries, 5:00 PM, Friday, April 23, 2010.

FIELD: 32 teams

STARTING TIMES: From 8:00 AM

DRESS CODE: Contestants may not wear jeans. Professionals may not wear shorts or skirts (amateurs may wear shorts).

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Contact the host professional for availability.

CART RESERVATIONS: Arrange through golf shop.

SEEDING FOR MATCH PLAY: Seeding for the Senior Washington PGA Championship will be based on the top 32 individual gross scores of the professionals in the Pro-Am. Seeding will use the USGA's standard pairings for match play events. Seeding for any professional who does not record a valid score from the Pro-Am will be determined by the Tournament Committee. Byes will fill out the brackets in the first round, if necessary. There will be a drop down bracket for those who lose their first round match. All professionals will play at least two matches.

NON-METAL SPIKES: It is a condition of the competition that metal spikes are prohibited. Traction systems using any form of metal spike will be prohibited. Penalty for Breach - Disqualification.

SEPARATE TEE POLICY: Although competing from separate tees, men and women competitors shall compete for the same purse.

COMPETITIONS

Senior Washington PGA Championship

Competition will be gross match play, based on seedings from the Pro-Am. Competitors are to arrange their own site and date to play their matches, but it must be within the time frame established by the Tournament Committee. A default site and date will not be established by the Committee. Match sites and dates should be communicated to the WWC Executive Director at least two days prior to the match. A competitor not present for his match shall be deemed to have conceded the match. If neither player is present for a designated match, the match may be rescheduled as long as it is before the deadline. If a match cannot be played prior to the deadline, both are deemed to have forfeited and the next opponent will receive a bye. All disputes shall be resolved by the Tournament Committee and its decision shall be final. Match deadlines will be forwarded to the competitors in a timely manner after the seeding event. There will be a drop down bracket for those who lose their first round match. All professionals will play at least two matches.

Senior Pro-Am

The team competition is best 2 net ball stroke play, with handicap strokes "where they fall" available to both professionals and amateurs. Competitors will use 90% of their current handicap in effect on April 24, 2009 for the team game. Gross and net (100% of handicap) individual prizes will be paid out in age divisions, based on entries. All individuals will be eligible for both gross and net prizes but may only win a prize in one division. Amateur prizes will be paid in the form of merchandise certificates. All prize ties shall be paid as ties.
