ELIGIBILITY

All contestants must at least 50 years of age on or before June 1, 2010.

\*There is no handicap limit for amateurs, but a maximum index of 24.0 will be allowed for the competition for those players exceeding this index. See reverse side for complete eligibility details. The revision in effect on May 27, 2010 will be used for this championship.

COMPETITION

Championship consists of 54 holes of stroke play. Professionals age 60 and over will be competing in an additional Super Senior division over the 54 holes (gross and net). There is a concurrent 36-hole pro-am competition, using one gross ball and one net ball at 90% handicap. See reverse side.

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The application included on the reverse side hereof is subject to acceptance by the PNW Section, PGA of America, and applicant agrees that in the event of its acceptance, it may be rejected or revoked at any time thereafter. To be accepted, entries must be signed, paid, and received at Tournament Headquarters. Therefore, players submitting entries are encouraged to allow ample time for delay or error in transmission of their entries.

Both the said Application and Applicant's participation in the aforesaid Invitational Championship (hereafter referred to as the "Championship") are subject to all Rules, Regulations, provisions of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America and other conditions applicable to the Championship, as well as to the terms and conditions of the agreement between the PNW Section, PGA of America and the Championship sponsor(s) with respect to same.

**NON-METAL SPIKE RELEASE** (if facility is spikeless): It is the requirement of the Host Club that all individuals using the Host Club golf course wear spikeless/non-metal golf shoes. This requirement is a policy of the Host Club and is not a policy of the Pacific Northwest Section of the PGA of America ("Section"). The use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes may result in the participant slipping on wet or damp surfaces (inclusive of but not necessarily limited to turf area, wooden areas such as bridges and pathways, etc.) and reduced traction on non-level areas of the golf course. As evidenced by the participant's signature on the front of this entry, the participant acknowledges that potential dangers relative to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes have been disclosed to participant and participant agrees to assume the risk of sustaining injury arising from or attributable to the use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises. The participant here releases the Section and Section's officers, directors, members, employees, successors and assigns (the "Indemnified Parties") from any and all claims for loss damage, inclusive of but not limited to personal injury, whether or not caused by participant's use of spikeless/non-metal golf shoes at the Host Club's premises in connection with the tournament. The consideration for this release is the permission granted by Section to the participant to participate in the golf tournament. This release binds not only the participant, but also the participant's spouse, heirs, legal representatives and assigns.

By this application, an applicant consents to references to him and pictures of him and his play in any publicity, radio and television broadcasting and other exhibition or publication, including their use in any commercial manner.

**ELIGIBLE PLAYERS:** The term "eligible player" is defined, for this Championship, as: (1) all Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America members (except those classified as "F" or "Inactive"); (2) all PNW Section, PGA of America apprentices with full Section Playing Privileges; (3) all CPGA members residing in the province of British Columbia who are in good standing with the CPGA; (4) amateurs as defined by the USGA with a recognized USGA or BCGA handicap index. All players must reach their 50th birthday on or before June 1, 2010. Contestants entering as amateurs may not accept professional prize money. Section 5 of the Tournament Regulations applies.

50 Teams, entry priority will be as follows:

- (1) Professionals who are members or apprentices of the Western Washington Chapter of the Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America or were a 2009 Senior Washington Open participant (must hold a current Pacific Northwest Section Player's Card). These players will have until May 14, 2010 to fill the field.
- (2) If spots remain, Professionals who are members or apprentices of the Pacific Northwest Section, PGA of America (must hold a current Pacific Northwest Section Player's Card). These players will have until May 21, 2010 to fill the field.
- (3) If spots remain, Professionals who are in good standing with the Canadian PGA and reside in the province of British Columbia may gain entry into the Championship.

**FIELD:** 50 teams

**STARTING TIMES:** Starting times will be available at the WWC Chapter office and the golf course on Friday, May 28. Competitors are responsible for knowing their starting time and tee.

**DRESS CODE:** Contestants may not wear jeans. Professionals may not wear shorts or skirts (amateurs may wear shorts).

**PRACTICE ROUNDS:** Any day by reservation. Special \$31 rate for amateurs Mon-Thur; \$35 Fri-Sun.

**NON-METAL SPIKES:** It is a condition of the competition that metal spikes are prohibited. Traction systems using any form of metal spike will be prohibited. Penalty for Breach - Disqualification.

**HUDSON CUP POINTS:** The appropriate Senior Hudson Cup points will be granted by the Section, OGA, and WSGA for this event.

**SEPARATE TEE POLICY:** Although competing from separate tees, men and women professionals shall compete for the same purse.

There will be a professional payout (gross scores only) and four amateur payouts (gross and net). Amateur divisions will be broken using ages of 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65+. Amateur payouts will be adjusted based on number of players in each division and will be weighted to the gross divisions.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>COMPETITIONS</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Professional Super Senior</b></p> <p>All professionals 60 and over are competing in a concurrent 54-hole stroke play championship, based on gross and net scores.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Pro-Am</b></p> <p>All competitors are competing in a concurrent 36 hole pro-am championship on Tuesday and Wednesday. It is scored using two best balls of the four, one gross and one net, at 90% handicap. The entire field will be re-paired for the final round based on their 36 hole individual scores.</p>
<p><b>NOTE: Amateurs are limited to winnings of \$750 for the entire championship.</b></p>
