The Orientation Committee proposes an adjustment to the Associate Mentoring Program for 2020 due to the unique recent circumstances surrounding COVID-19. With all Chapter and Section events being put on hold for the foreseeable future, we believe it is best to put these measures in place to assist our associates during this difficult time.

- If Section and Chapters are restored to normal state of business on or before June 1st, we propose requiring only TWO AMP CREDITS for 2020.
- If Section and Chapters are not restored to normal state of business by August 1st, we propose requiring NO AMP CREDITS for 2020.
- Associates that started 2020 suspended for owing AMP Credits from past year(s), remain in suspension until they complete their delinquent credits but would follow the same guideline as above for 2020.
- If the Section Board adds any online Education and/or Meetings, we would like to count any of those online videos as AMP credits (for 2020 or backdate them for those that need them). We'd suggest Education opportunities online (approved by Section Staff) an hour or more to count as an AMP Education credit. We would also suggest any online Section Meetings to count as an AMP Education or an AMP Meeting credit.

The Orientation Committee feels that our recent unique situations are not a time to be hard on Associates for the current year. Once golf courses open back up, we recognize that it will be difficult for Associates to leave work to attend required Meetings and Education opportunities. This is a time for a little extra understanding and offering different ways to receive their AMP Credits.
